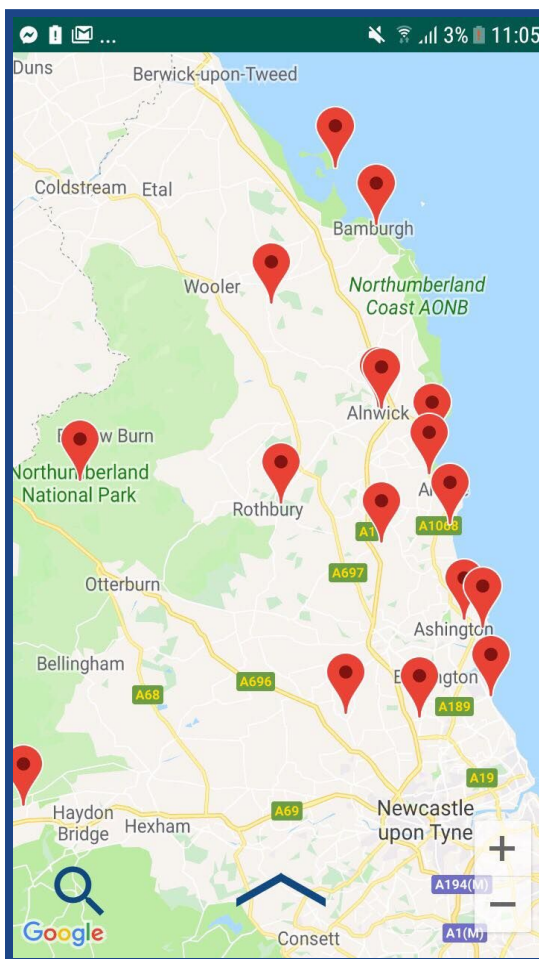

## Splash Screen and the Main Map Page



When you first open the app you'll see this splash screen which will transition into the main map page once it's loaded.

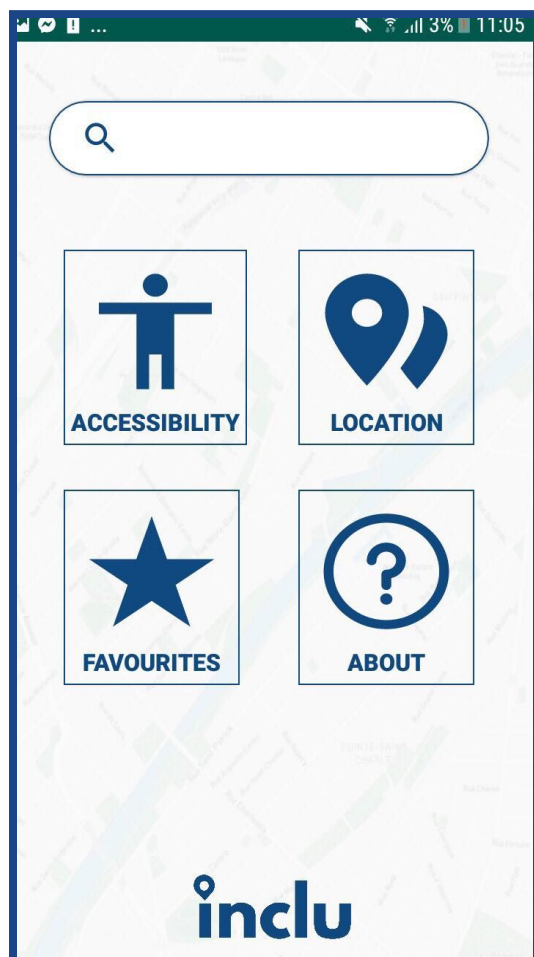


The main map page will feature a location marker for each attraction, a search icon which launches the search function, an up arrow button which launches the main menu page and zoom buttons.

The Main Map Page will show red pin markers for each attraction, when accessibility and/or location filters are activated the appropriate markers will be displayed in blue. Click on a pin once to display a label, click a second time to go to the attraction page.

Zooming can be done with either the two buttons or with a two-finger pinch. You can also move around the map with a swiping motion.

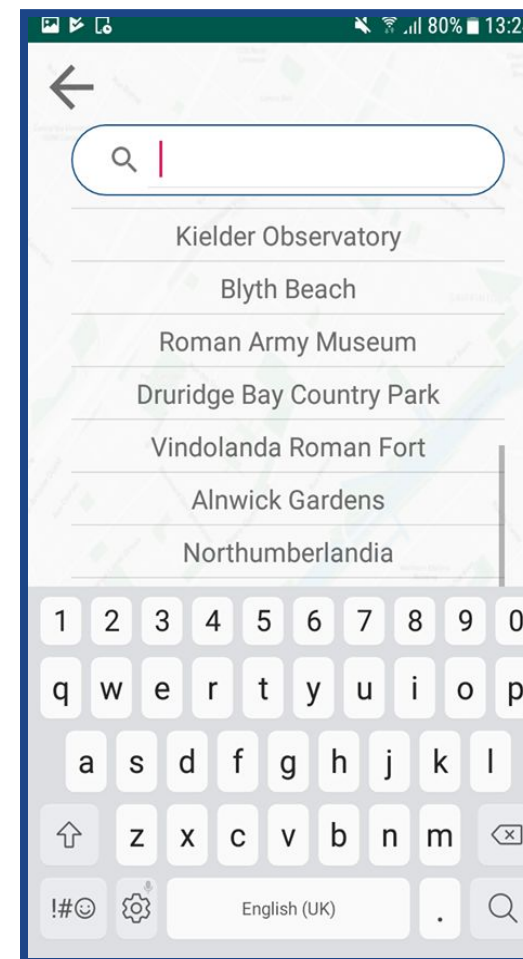
## Main Menu Page and the Search Function



From the Main Menu Page you can access the search function, the accessibility and location filters pages, the favourites page, and the about page.



When you click on the search bar this list of attractions will be shown which can be used to access their individual attraction pages. You can swipe up and down the list to view more.

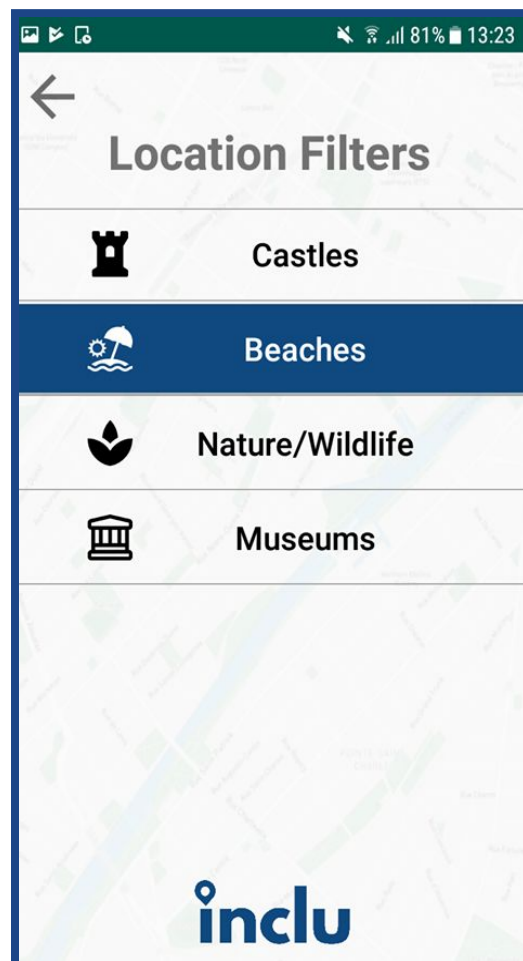


You can either tap on the search bar and type in the name of an attraction, or scroll through the list to pick.

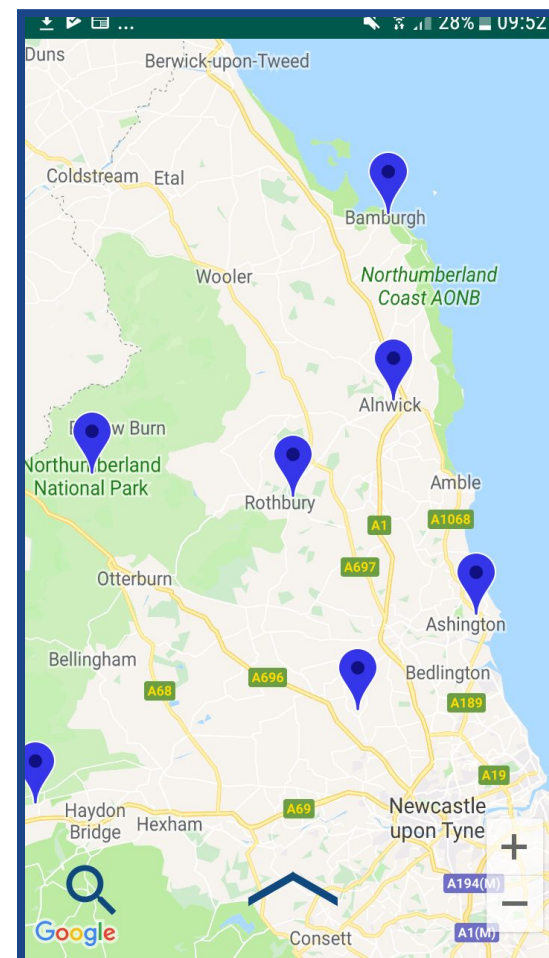
## Accessibility and Location Filters



You can select and deselect different accessibility filters by clicking on them and press back to see the results.

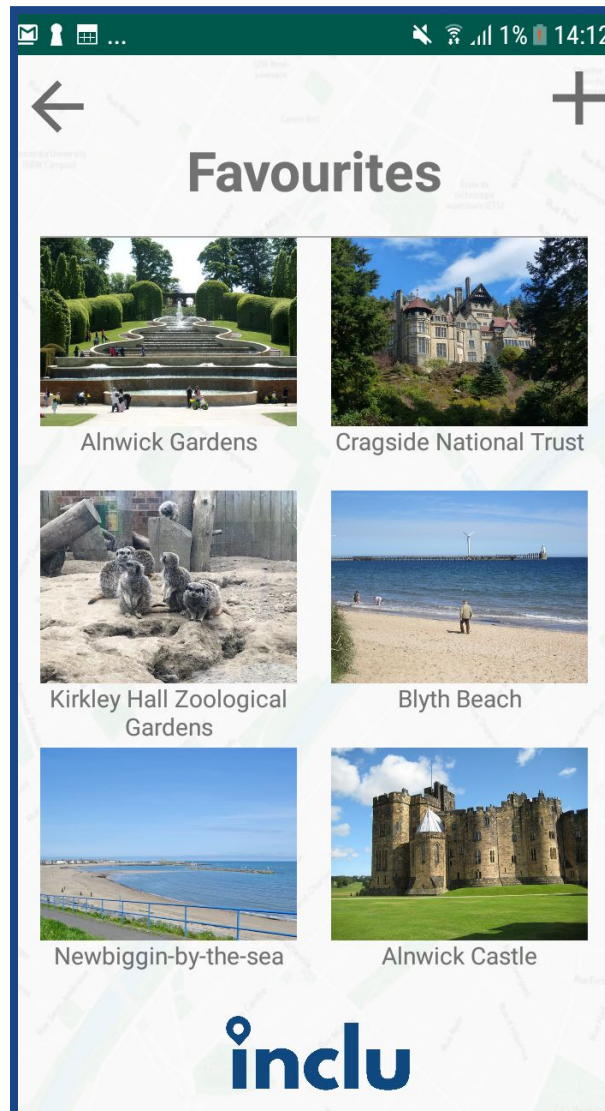


You can select and deselect different location filters by clicking on them and press back to see the results.



Attractions matching these accessibility and/or location filters will be displayed on the map with blue pins.

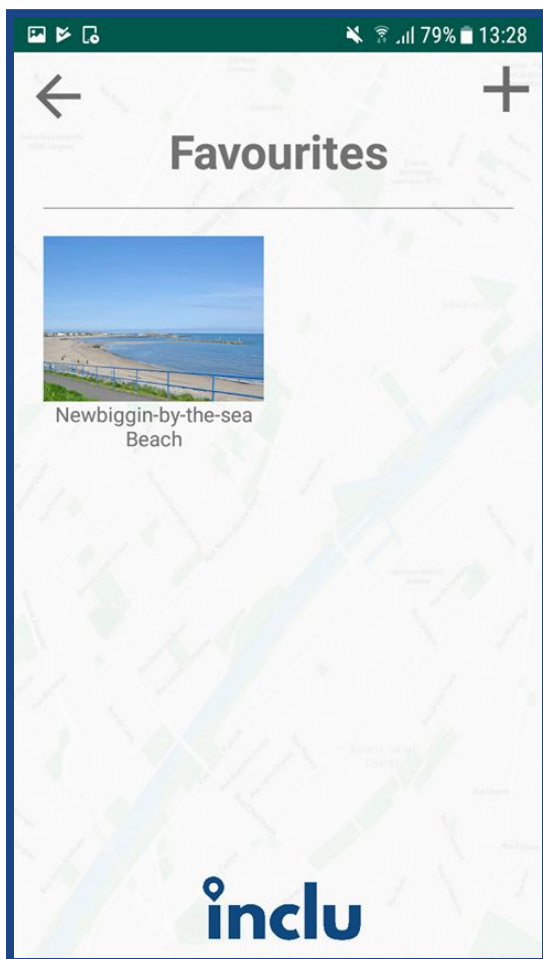
## Favourites



The favourites page shows the name and image of all the user's selected favourites. We will show you 2 ways of adding favourites and the way to remove favourites.

You can click the back button to return to the main menu page.

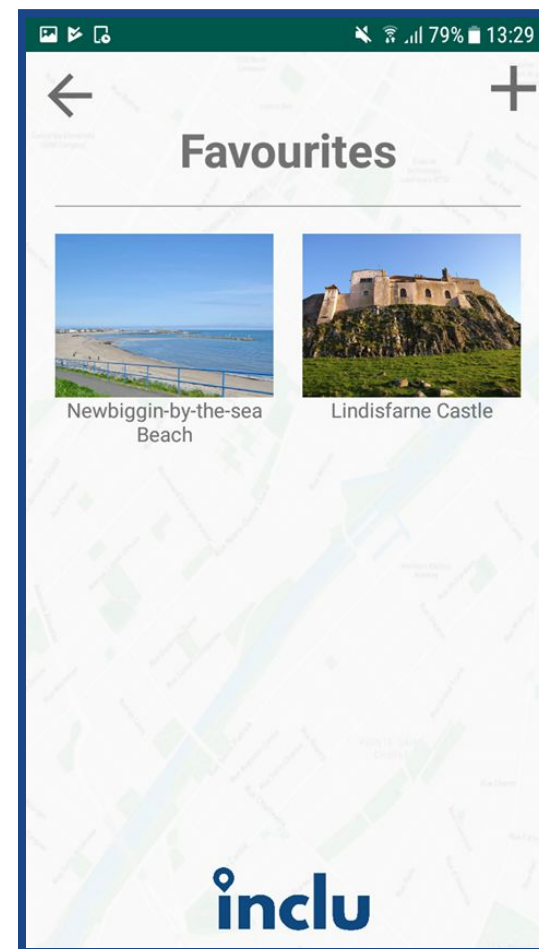
## Favourites - add by '+' button



Attractions can be added to the favourites page through the '+' button in the top right of this page.

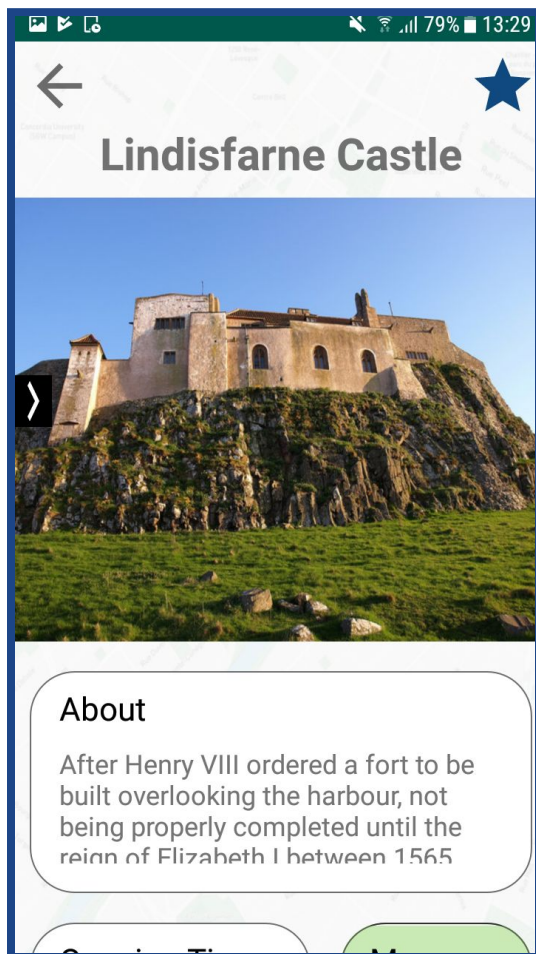


This launches the search function, here you can scroll through the list of attractions or search for a particular one. Click it to add it to the favourites.

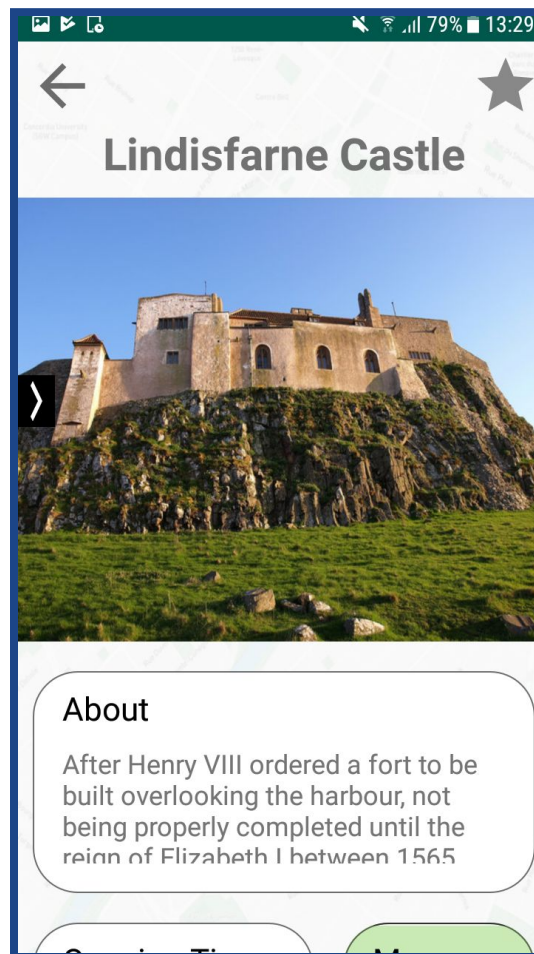


Once the back button is clicked, you can see that it has been added to the list.

Favourited attraction.

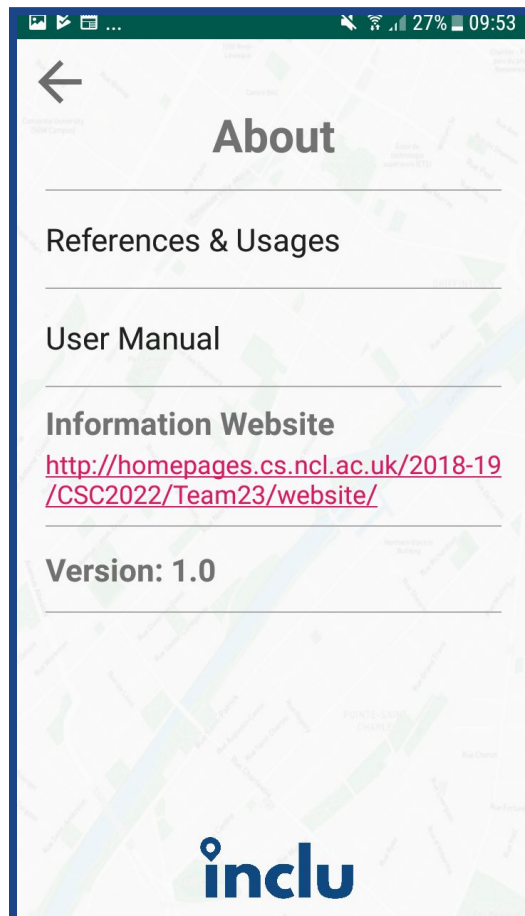


Non-favourited attraction.

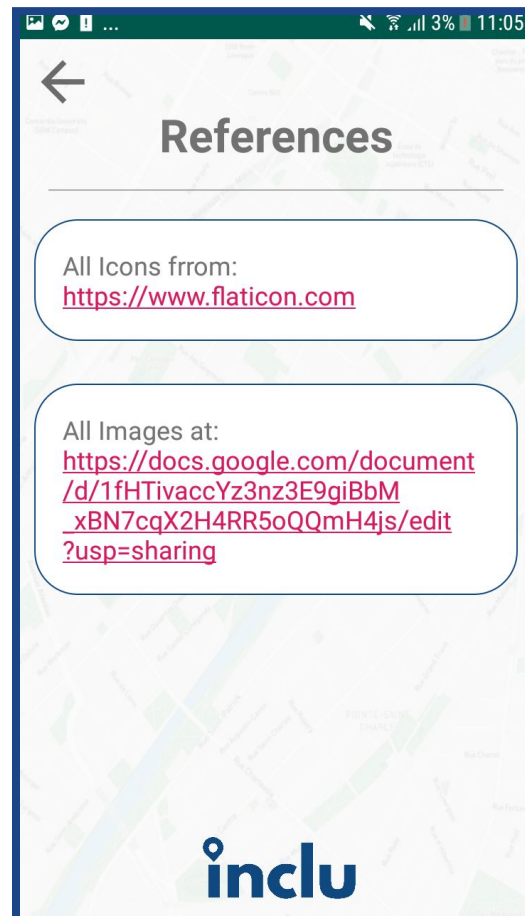
Attractions can be added and removed to the favourites page through the individual attraction pages as well. The star is grey for non-favourited attractions and blue for favourited attractions.



## About



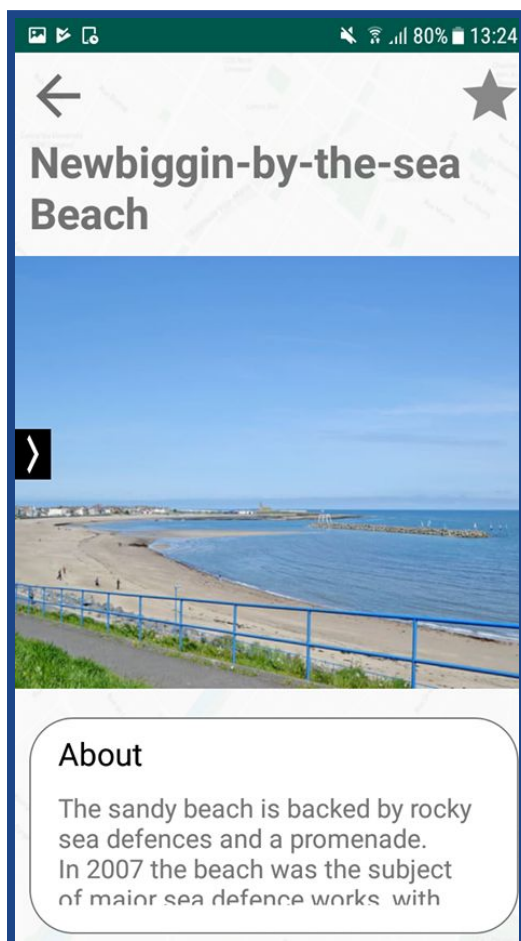
About Page, click the back arrow to return to the Main Menu page.



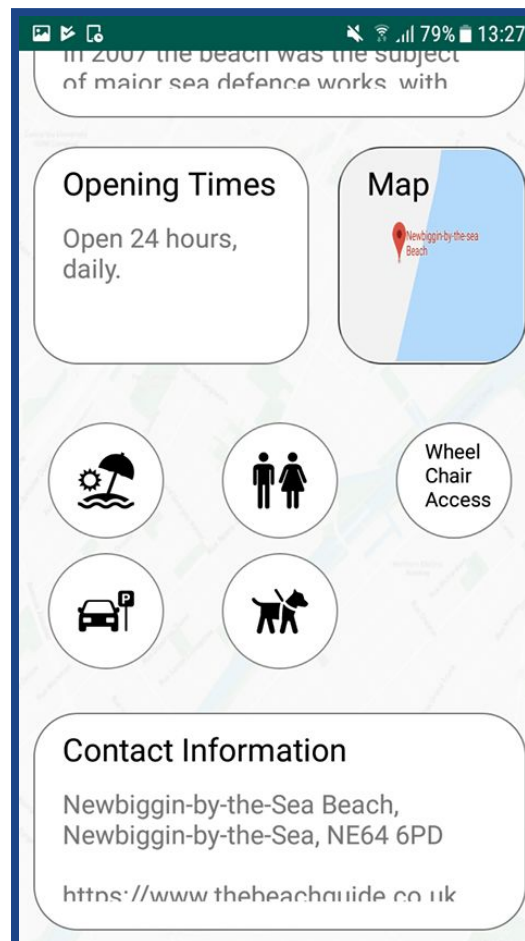
References & Usage page, click the back arrow to return to the About page.

The About page has a link to the References & Usages page which links the icon and image references. It also links the User Manual, the Information Website and the version information.

## Attraction Page



You can favourite/unfavourite attractions using the star in the top right corner, and the 'About' card can be clicked on to expand the box if not all of the information is displayed.







You can scroll to view more information. The 'Opening Times' and 'Contact Information' cards can be clicked on to view more text. Click on the Map card to take you to the main map page with the attraction highlighted. Location and accessibility icons are displayed, which when clicked, show text instead of the icon if you're unsure what the icon represents.









Swiping right or clicking on the arrow on the left will take you to the gallery page where you can view multiple images of the attraction. You can scroll to see more images and return to the attraction page by swiping left or clicking the arrow on the left.
