Assignment 4: Reflective report

Objectives

- To summarise the work carried out during your placement
- To summarise the skills gained, achievements, lessons learnt and future plans following the placement

Summary

Use your log book and experience gained during the placement year to help you write a reflective report which describes the experience you have gained during the placement, in terms of achievements, lessons learnt and future plans. Describe major pieces of work completed, responsibilities and contribution to any other work or projects undertaken by your organisation.

Assessment criteria

The submission will be marked out of 40. This submission constitutes 40% of the total assessment for the Industrial Placement. The placement year itself is assessed as pass/fail; marks for the individual assignments do not contribute to your overall degree classification, which is awarded based on your stage 2 and stage 3 marks.

Marks of 30 or above will be obtained for a clear, well-organised summary which includes the aspects referred to above (achievements, lessons learnt, work carried out, contribution to other projects) and shows mature reflection on the outcomes of the placement year.

You should upload a word or pdf document of 5-10 pages to Ness by the due date. You can refer, in this document, to evidence contained in your log– you do not need to repeat the evidence in this report.
